

Wolfden Completes \$2M Financing with its Strategic Partners Altius Minerals Corporation and Kinross Gold Corporation

Thunder Bay, Ontario, January 27, 2021 - Wolfden Resources Corporation (WLF.V) ("Wolfden" or the "Company") is pleased to announce that it has completed a non-brokered private placement of 6,250,000 common shares of the Company ("Common Shares") at a price of C\$0.32 per Common Share with Altius Minerals Corporation ("Altius") and Kinross Gold Corporation ("Kinross") for gross proceeds of \$2 million (the "Offering"). Altius now holds approximately 12.6% and Kinross holds approximately 11.4% of the issued and outstanding shares of the Company.

The majority of the proceeds from the Offering will be used to continue exploration at the Company's 100%-owned Pickett Mountain high-grade polymetallic deposit and also at its recently optioned Big Silver project, both located in Maine, USA. As part of the terms of the subscription agreement, the Company will continue to collaborate with and gain support from its strategic shareholders on technical programs related to the exploration and development of the projects.

"We are very pleased to have the continued support of Altius and Kinross as a significant investors and as strategic partners as we increase our exploration focus on precious metal rich polymetallic deposits and seek to further expand the mineral resources including high-grade mineralization intersected in the final holes of the 2020 drill program in the footwall of the Picket Mountain deposit," said Ron Little, President and CEO for the Company. "The Company has been working in parallel on an application to rezone a small portion of its Pickett Mountain Property to allow for an underground mining operation and hopes to conclude the process in 2021 with a favorable outcome".

Brian Dalton, President and CEO for Altius stated, "We continue to support Wolfden as it successfully advances its high-grade projects and continues to work collaboratively with stakeholders to prove its commitment to sustainable mining within Maine. This is a natural resource rich area of North America that has been underexplored for decades and the metals that Wolfden is seeking to produce there are critical to the enabling of the industries that will contribute to a more sustainable future in the USA and globally."

The financing has been approved by the TSX Venture Exchange and no compensation has been paid in respect of the financing. The securities issued are subject to a four-month hold period under applicable Canadian securities laws, which expires on May 28, 2021.

As an insider, Altius was considered to be related party transactions within the meaning of TSXV Policy 5.9 and Multilateral Instrument 61-101 ("**MI 61-101**"). The Company relied on the exemptions from the valuation and minority shareholder approval requirements of MI 61-101 contained in sections 5.5(a) and 5.7(a) of MI 61-101 in respect of such insider participation.

Its wholly owned Pickett Mountain Project is one of the highest-grade polymetallic projects in North America (Zn, Pb, Cu, Ag, Au).
